



QUICK SIZE GUIDE

Use our measuring chart to assess the fitting you require. Please wear your usual hosiery or socks when measuring your feet.

- For ladies' shoes, use the pink chart.
- For men's shoes, use the blue chart.

This is a guide only; to ensure correct fitting footwear we advise seeking professional advice.

1 Measuring foot length

- Place the measuring chart against a wall or upright surface so A is touching the wall.
- · Place heel on the chart as shown.
- Select the first line beyond your longest toe and note the size.
- Repeat for your other foot.
- Your size is the size of your largest foot.

2 Measuring foot width

- If possible use a flexible measuring tape. Otherwise, cut out our tape measure.
- Measure your foot circumference (in millimetres) at the widest point as shown - around your big toe and little toe joints - and note the measurement.
- Ensure your weight is fully on your foot when you measure it.
- Repeat for your other foot.
- Your width is the circumference of your largest foot.

3 Finding your size

- Use our handy charts to find your size.
- For ladies' shoes, use the pink chart.
- For men's shoes, use the blue chart.
- · Locate your size in the left column.
- On the same line, find the nearest number above your foot width.
- Note your fitting at the top of that column.
- See example below if your foot measures 240mm and your size is 6. You can wear EITHER a 4E, V or 2V fitting.
